## Club Honour Boards

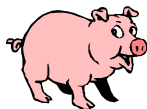

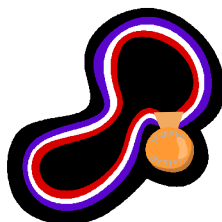

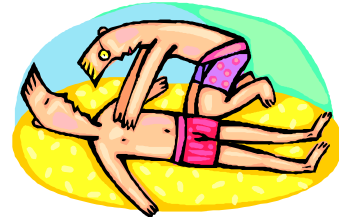
