Cricket Program Sales 2005/06

Once again, the club has been given a fantastic opportunity to make some money and give something back to our members at the same time. We have again been asked to supply people to sell programs at the international cricket at Adelaide Oval this summer.

The first game we need to cover is the Australia vs West Indies Test Match, in particular the dates 25th, 26th, and 27th of November.

We have also been asked to supply people to cover the South Africa vs Sri Lanka one dayer on January 24th, and the Australia vs Sri Lanka one dayer on the 26th of January.

There is also a chance that we may be given to opportunity to sell the programs at the first one dayer final, on the 10th of February – Although we are still awaiting confirmation that we will be required. Should we be needed for this match, priority will be given to those that assisted at the Test Match and/or the South Africa vs Sri Lanka one dayer.

A minimum of 8 to 10 people is ideal for each day, as we may have 4 entrances to cover. For those that have done this before, you will remember that a great day is had by all. For those that haven't, what the day involves is a few hours of selling the programs to the public (of which the club is paid a commission of sales), and after that – Free members area access is supplied to all. This means being able to sit in the stands, and enjoying all the perks of members access, at no cost.
